The CASF summer intern will work directly with the teaching team in Guasmo Sur, Ecuador. The intern will assist in the development and implementation of lesson plans, prepare his/her own unit of study, lead parent-teacher conferences, and participate in various other community initiatives.

The deadline for this application is November 15, 2018. Please complete the application and send it to Christine Olt at christine.cotton@auf-ecuador.org before the deadline.

We will schedule personal interviews between November 15, 2018 and the end of December, 2018 via Skype. A decision will be made by January 15, 2019, and you will be notified of the decision by this date.

Other important details:

- Before you accept the summer internship position you will need to sign a covenant of conduct that will be explained at the interview.
- You need to be available to begin the internship by approximately May 15 (exact date to be determined). The duration of the internship is approximately three months (May 15-August 15, 2019).
- Your airfare will be provided along with a living allowance for the duration of the internship. Interns are required to stay with a local host family for the duration of their stay. Interns are expected to work Monday-Friday, with occasional evening requirements.
